#### **PROJECT SCOPE**

The works comprise overcladding using our insulated aluminium rainscreen and high-performance integrated windows as part of a range of energy efficiency and

carbon saving measures in collaboration with Veolia, a leader in resource and energy management solutions.







Funding for the project was secured through the Public Sector Decarbonisation Scheme (PSDS) for affordable, low-carbon heating and energy efficiency upgrades across the public sector.
